

English Language Courses

General English

CRICOS Code: 071758K

General English classes focus on communicative English, providing opportunities for conversation with English speakers at elementary, pre-intermediate, intermediate and upper-intermediate levels. Depending on your requirements, programs run from five to 50 weeks in duration, and provide 25 hours of face-to-face teaching each week.

English for Academic Purposes (EAP)

CRICOS Code: 064715B

EAP offers an introduction to university life in Australia and teaches the academic skills needed to study successfully in an Australian university.

- Students who do not meet the English language proficiency requirements for their chosen SCU degree can choose an English language entry pathway at the SCU ELCs.
- Students require an IELTS test score or equivalent to determine the number of weeks of English Language studies. See Southern Cross University English language pathways table on the back of this brochure.
- Successful completion of the EAP course leads to direct entry into SCU degrees without undertaking further external tests.

IELTS Preparation

International English Language Testing System (IELTS) classes offer opportunities through specialised lessons designed for success in the IELTS examinations.

Other study options

Part-time and short English courses are ideal for students who are unable to attend full-time study but still wish to develop and expand their English skills. Courses are for students on tourist or working holiday visas. These courses are offered at SCU Gold Coast only.

Study tours can be specifically designed for the needs of particular groups, and can be taught and assessed so that English study in Australia is given credit as an integral part of students' courses at their home university.

Customised programs are available for groups of international university students, academics, government personnel, professional and specific industry groups. A flexible combination of English language training, guest lectures, workshops and site visits can be individually tailored to meet the training needs of participants.
