The Public Policy Network (PPN) is an informal network of Australasian public policy scholars that meets annually to discuss public policy research, teaching and cognate issues. Our conferences are run in workshop style as a single stream to facilitate discussion of issues across sessions and papers. Our focus is on policy theory and Australian and New Zealand policy issues as well as broader and comparative public policy research and the links between policy research and policy practice.

Abstracts for papers for the PPN Conference 2013 are now invited for immediate submission.

Papers will be selected dependent upon quality and relevance in the broad field of public policy in Australasia.

All submissions must include contact details.

Abstracts should be no more than 200 words in length, and should nominate a category from the following list:

1. Full paper, peer-reviewed
2. Full paper, non-peer-reviewed
3. Formative paper for discussion and feedback
4. Themed panel discussion
5. Doctoral student submission to RHD panel
