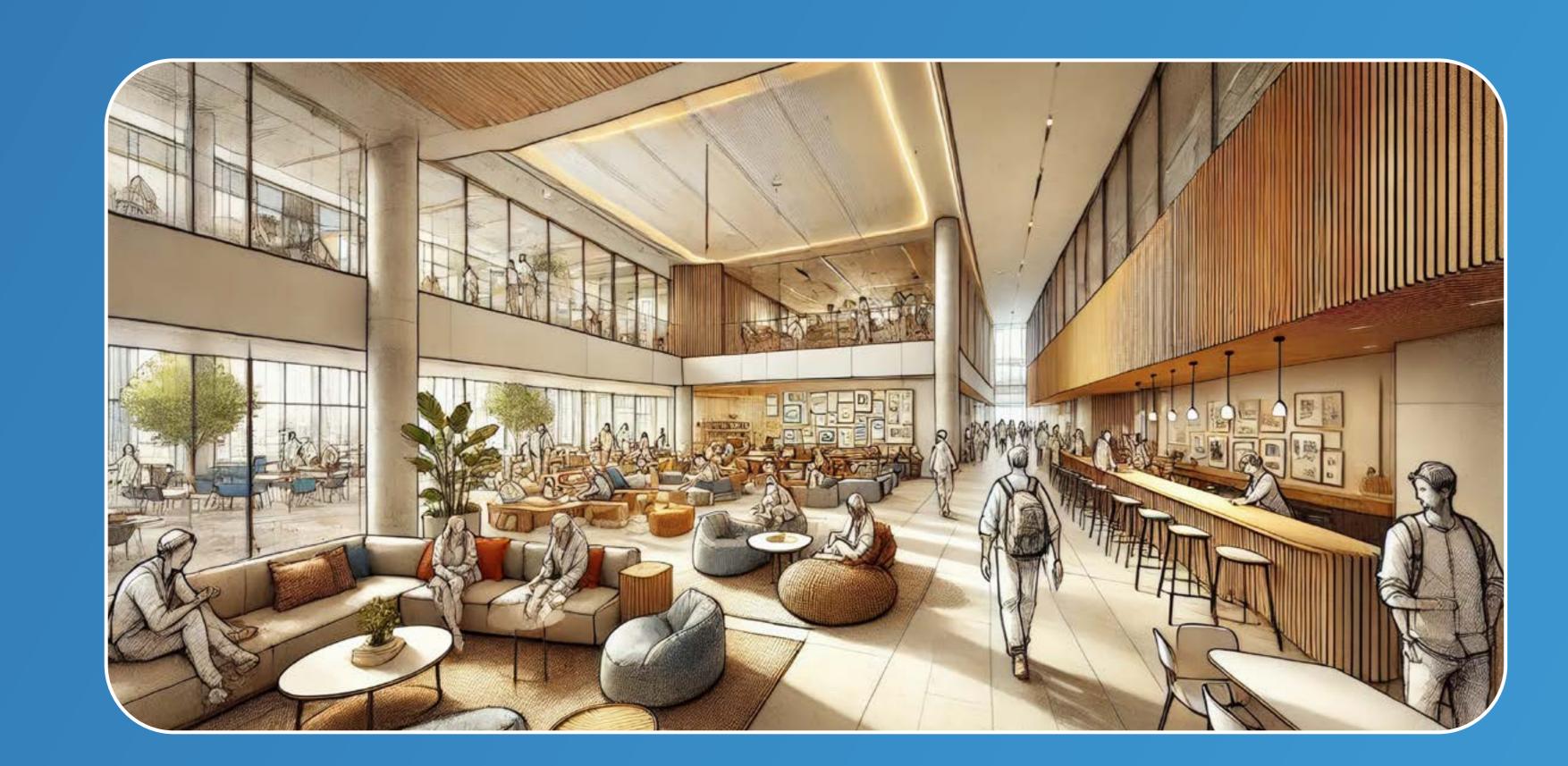


Dear Students
