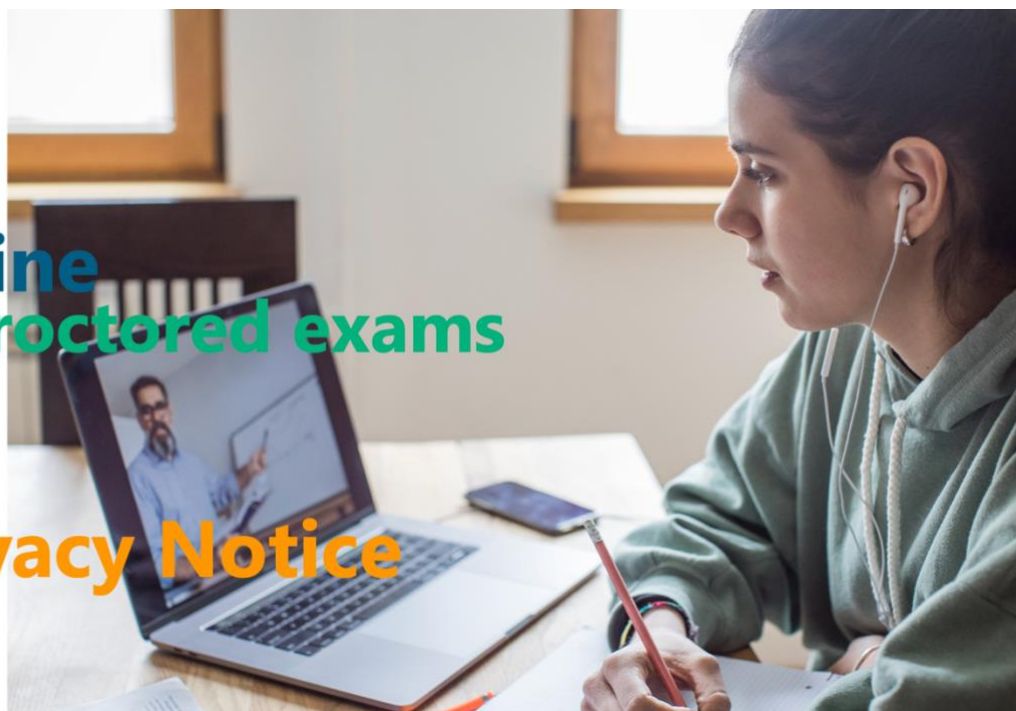

Privacy Notice – Online Examination and Assessment Proctoring Services

When you use Proctortrack software for onboarding or completing an examination or assessment task, the University will have access to and may collect your personal information for the purpose of verifying your identity and proctoring your online assessment task or examination and for related administrative and reporting purposes.

Proctortrack is a software developed by Verificent Technologies Inc. licensed by Janison Solutions Pty Ltd, which is a third-party provider contracted by the University to facilitate online proctoring of examinations and assessment tasks.
