Thesis Description:

My study aims to design and implement a teacher-training model based on heutagogy approach. In this respect, double-loop learning, reflective practice, and capability development are the main features in heutagogy as ways to generate learning experiences, encourage ideas, and reinforce previous learning. Collaborative learning also plays an important role in heutagogy, wherein sharing ideas, peer-to-peer reflection, and collective interpretation take place. The methodology of embedded design will be employed in my investigation. The findings of this study are expected to be significant for the improvement of teacher-training in Indonesia, particularly in North Sumatera.
