Collecting and sending hair samples to EAL

EAL Environmental Analysis Laboratory

1. SAMPLE COLLECTION AND PRESERVATION

- Minimum of 0.2-0.4 g of hair is required - equivalent to one heaped tablespoon - in a clean zip lock plastic bag or envelope
- An additional 0.2 g of hair is required for lodine analysis
- Hair should be clean, preferably washed with baby shampoo, well rinsed and dried. Cut small amounts of hair from the nape of the neck, close to the scalp
- Label bag with identification and date of sampling



- Download SSF and Price List from the EAL website www.scu.edu.au/eal
- Complete all relevant details
 on SSF
- Use test code SS-PACK-050 from the Price List
- Credit card and cheque are the preferred methods of payment

3. PACKAGE AND SEND SAMPLES

- Package sealed sample(s) in a postpak, suitable envelope or small box
- Enclose SSF in a sealed plastic sleeve along with any instructions
- Send or deliver to EAL
