

Collecting and sending essential oil samples to EAL



1. SAMPLE COLLECTION AND PRESERVATION

- Use only glass containers as most oils dissolve plastic - glass bottle with a hard plastic childproof lid is best
- Provide at least 25 mL of clear oil with no visible water or contaminants
- Fill the bottle as full as possible to reduce oxidation in transit
- Label the vial with sample name and date of sampling

2. COMPLETE EAL SAMPLE SUBMISSION FORM (SSF)

- Download SSF and Price List from the EAL website www.scu.edu.au/eal
- Complete all relevant details on SSF
- Use the test code SW-PACK-059 for OC/OP pesticides or SW-PACK-030 for metal contaminants
- Credit card and cheque are the preferred methods of payment

3. PACKAGE AND SEND SAMPLES

- Package sealed sample(s) in a postpak, suitable envelope or small box
- Enclose SSF in a sealed plastic sleeve along with any other instructions
- Send or deliver to EAL - post and courier labels below
