

Comparable prior learning – Indonesia

Schedule 1, in clause 13 of the [Advanced Standing and Recognition of Prior Learning Procedures](#), prescribes the credit that applies for prior learning in a discipline-related Australian qualification or occupational/voluntary experience. Below is the equivalence between Australian and Indonesian learning for awarding credit at Southern Cross University.

All applicants must meet the University's [English language requirements for admission](#).

Previously complete or incomplete qualifications allow the University to formulate a selection rank to determine eligibility for a place of study at Southern Cross University. Credit is awarded for the highest level of related learning achieved in the same or a closely allied discipline/field/branch of learning. For example, holding two related Diplomas (or a double diploma) provides a maximum of 8 units credit, not 16 units. Less credit may be granted due to partially related learning in a different discipline/field/branch of learning, external/professional recognition requirements or mandatory units in the study plan, for which credit does not apply. More credit may be awarded for greater alignment of learning outcomes, through waiver by the Deputy Vice Chancellor, Academic.

The guidelines are only relevant for qualifications that have been accredited (*terakreditasi*) via the current accreditation system, *Badan Akreditasi Nasional Perguruan Tinggi (BAN-PT)*, or National Accreditation Board for Tertiary Educational Institutions. Students who study EAP with SCU College do not need to sit an IELTS or equivalent English language test to continue their study in another SCU degree.

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
