Southern Cross University is offering international students currently studying at Southern Cross University or another Australian university the opportunity to apply for a **Advancement Scholarship**. The **Advancement Scholarship Application** must be submitted with the **International Application for Admission** form. Successful applicants will be notified in their **Offer**.

The **Advancement Scholarship** provides students with a **\$8,000 fee reduction** on each year, paid in instalments throughout each study year, commencing in the first session and continuing, based on successful completion of each study session.

A. ELIGIBILITY

Students wishing to apply for the **Advancement Scholarship** are required to satisfy the following criteria:

1. Apply to study full-time (8 units per year), full undergraduate or postgraduate coursework degree at either the Gold Coast, Lismore or Coffs Harbour campus.
2. Completed either:
 - a. An undergraduate or postgraduate degree at Southern Cross University
 - b. Two sessions of Study Abroad at Southern Cross University.
3. Meet the minimum admission requirements of the University.
Undergraduate entry: A qualification equivalent to Australian Year 12 and the required entry grade for the program for which they have applied; and English language comparable to Academic IELTS 6.0 overall with no band less than 5.5.*
Postgraduate entry: A qualification equivalent to an Australian Bachelor degree; and English language comparable to Academic IELTS 6.5*.
4. Students must successfully complete all units in their progression, by obtaining at least a pass in all units, to remain eligible for the scholarship.
5. Students must meet the attendance requirements of their program and student visa to remain eligible for the scholarship
6. Citizens or permanent residents of Australia or New Zealand are not eligible to apply.

The **Advancement Scholarship** is governed by the following terms and conditions:

1. The scholarship is only available to eligible international students who are undertaking on-campus full-time degree study at the Southern Cross University main campuses:
 - a. Gold Coast, Queensland (Regional)
 - b. Lismore, New South Wales (Regional)
 - c. Coffs Harbour, New South Wales (Regional).
2. The scholarship is awarded, at the discretion of the University, to eligible international students who have completed an undergraduate degree at Southern Cross University or another Australian university or completed two sessions of Study Abroad at Southern Cross University. This excludes applicants progressing to an undergraduate or postgraduate degree from a pathway program.
3. Applicants must meet eligibility criteria set out in Section A Eligibility.
4. The scholarship is not available in conjunction with other scholarships.
5. The scholarship is not transferable to a third party.
6. The scholarship remains valid whilst the recipient:
 - a. Remains enrolled in full-time study at Southern Cross University; and
 - b. Remains enrolled in the program listed on their **Offer**; and
 - c. Pays all tuition and additional fees/costs and
 - d. Meets the conditions of their Student Visa.
7. The scholarship will lapse if the **Offer** has passed the lapse date.
8. The scholarship will lapse if the student named on the **Offer** cancels their enrolment at Southern Cross University.
9. The scholarship is not redeemable in cash and subject to the the student complying with all terms and conditions and will be credited in instalments, to the student's fees at the rate of \$8,000 per study year.
10. The scholarship may be withdrawn with 10 days written notice, should the recipient breach any of these conditions.
11. There is a limited number of scholarships available.
