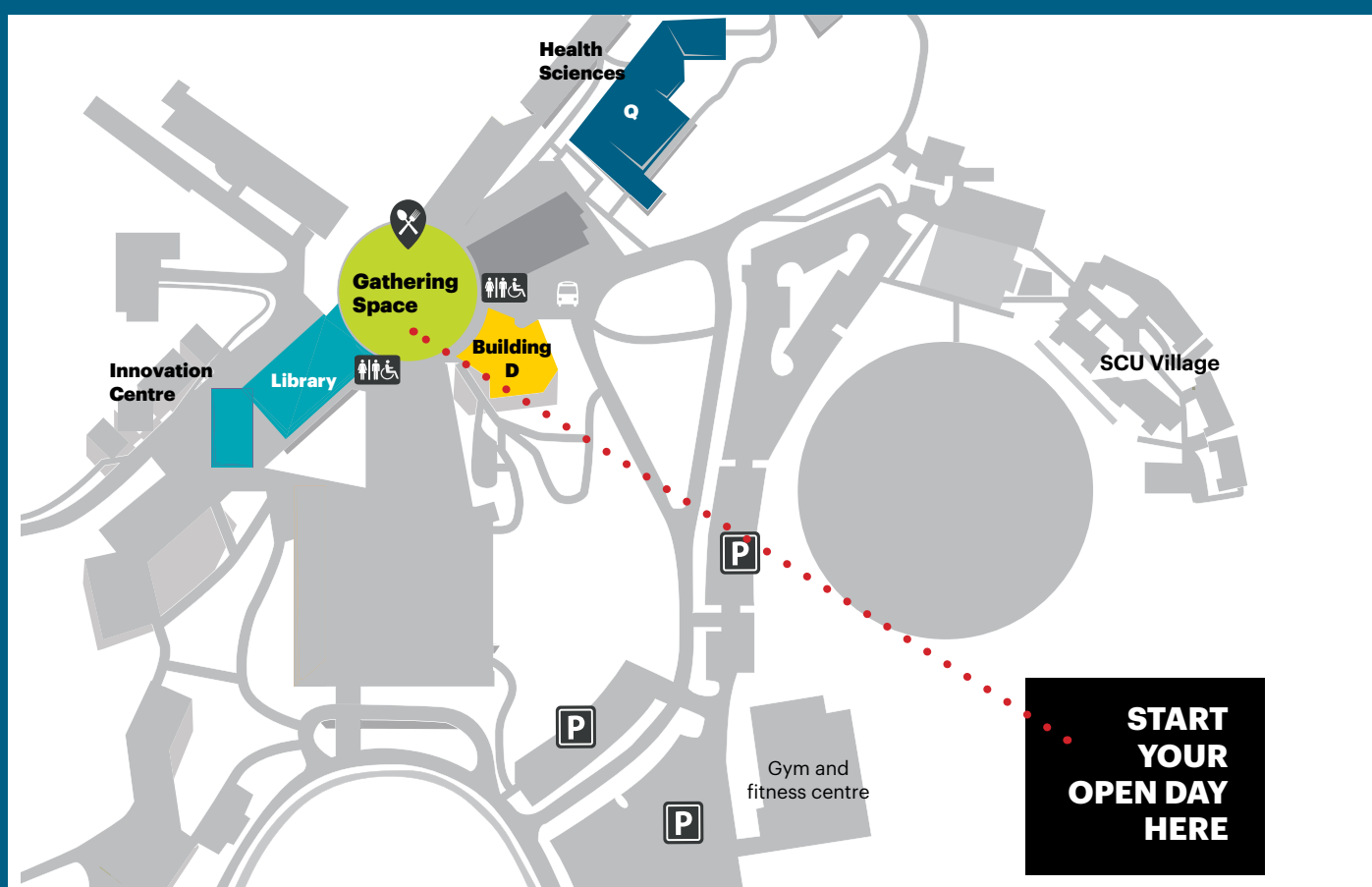

GUIDED WALKING TOURS

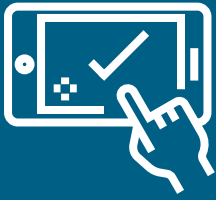
Departs on the half hour (ie. first tour at 3.30pm, 4.30pm, 5.30pm).
