Southern Cross University is offering international students the opportunity to apply for a **SCU International Women in STEM Scholarship**. The **SCU International Women in STEM Scholarship Application** must be submitted with the **International Application for Admission** form. Successful applicants will be notified in their **Offer**.

The **SCU International Women in STEM Scholarship** provides students with a **\$5,000 fee reduction** on the second session tuition fees (a one off reduction), after successful completion of their first study session at Southern Cross University.

## A. ELIGIBILITY

Students wishing to apply for the **SCU International Women in STEM Scholarship** are required to satisfy the following criteria:

1. The applicant must be a female international onshore student.
2. Apply to study a full-time (8 units per year) postgraduate coursework degree from the School of Environment Science and Engineering or School of Health and Human Science at either the Gold Coast, Lismore or Coffs Harbour campus.
3. Applicant must have a high academic performance in maths and science and meet the minimum admission requirements of the University.  
**Undergraduate entry:** A qualification equivalent to Australian Year 12 and the required entry grade for the program for which they have applied; and English language comparable to Academic IELTS 6.0 overall with no band less than 5.5.\*  
**Postgraduate entry:** A qualification equivalent to an Australian Bachelor degree; and English language comparable to Academic IELTS 6.5\*.
4. Students must successfully complete all units in their first session, by obtaining at least a pass in all units, to remain eligible for the scholarship.
5. Citizens or permanent residents of Australia or New Zealand are not eligible to apply.

1. The scholarship is only available to eligible international students who are undertaking on-campus full-time degree study at the Southern Cross University main campuses:
  - a. Gold Coast, Queensland
  - b. Lismore, New South Wales (Regional)
  - c. Coffs Harbour, New South Wales (Regional).
2. The scholarship is awarded, at the discretion of the University.
3. The scholarship is not available to students for a program they are studying in conjunction with other scholarships.
4. The scholarship is not transferable to a third party.
5. The scholarship remains valid whilst the recipient:
  - a. Remains enrolled in full-time study at Southern Cross University; and
  - b. Remains enrolled in the program listed on their **Offer**; and
  - c. Pays all tuition and additional fees/costs; and
  - d. Meets the conditions of their Student Visa.
6. The scholarship will lapse if the **Offer** has passed the lapse date.
7. The scholarship will lapse if the student named on the **Offer** cancels their enrolment at Southern Cross University.
8. The scholarship is not redeemable in cash and subject to the the student complying with all terms and conditions will be credited to the student's second session fees.
9. The scholarship may be withdrawn with 10 days written notice, should the recipient breach any of these conditions.
10. There is a limited number of scholarships available.
