Southern Cross University is offering international students the opportunity to apply for a **SCU International Women in STEM Scholarship**. The **SCU International Women in STEM Scholarship Application** must be submitted with the **International Application for Admission** form. Successful applicants will be notified in their **Offer**.

The **SCU International Women in STEM Scholarship** provides students with a **\$8,000 maximum fee reduction** for your first scholarship year. For continuing scholarship year/s the value is merit based and calculated on the previous scholarships year's course GPA (across your 8 units*). If your GPA falls below 5.5 your scholarship amount will decrease as listed in the Terms and Conditions. Payments will be applied per unit to the maximum scholarship amount for that scholarship year.

A. ELIGIBILITY

Students wishing to apply for the **SCU International Women in STEM Scholarship** are required to satisfy the following criteria:

1. The applicant must be a female international onshore student.
2. Apply to study a full-time (8 units per year) postgraduate coursework degree from the School of Environment Science and Engineering or School of Health and Human Science at either the Gold Coast, Lismore or Coffs Harbour campus.
3. Applicant must have a high academic performance in maths and science and meet the minimum admission requirements of the University.

Undergraduate entry: A qualification equivalent to Australian Year 12 and the required entry grade for the program for which they have applied; and English language comparable to Academic IELTS 6.0 overall with no band less than 5.5.*

Postgraduate entry: A qualification equivalent to an Australian Bachelor degree; and English language comparable to Academic IELTS 6.5*.

4. For continuing scholarship year/s the value is merit based and calculated on the previous scholarships year's course GPA (across your 8 units* completed):
Course GPA 4.0 to 5.4 - \$5000
Course GPA 5.5 to 7.0 - \$8000
5. Students must meet the attendance requirements of their program and student visa to remain eligible for the scholarship.
6. Citizens or permanent residents of Australia or New Zealand are not eligible to apply.

*Please note variations may apply for certain courses. Please refer to www.scu.edu.au/courses and check the admission requirements.

The **SCU International Women in STEM Scholarship** is governed by the following terms and conditions:

1. The scholarship is only available to eligible female international students who are undertaking on-campus full-time degree study at the Southern Cross University main campuses:
 - a. Gold Coast, Queensland (Regional)
 - b. Lismore, New South Wales (Regional)
 - c. Coffs Harbour, New South Wales (Regional).
2. The scholarship is awarded, at the discretion of the University.
3. The scholarship is not available in conjunction with other scholarships.
4. The scholarship is not transferable to a third party.
5. The scholarship remains valid whilst the recipient:
 - a. Remains enrolled in full-time study (96 credit points*) at Southern Cross University per scholarship year; and
 - b. Remains enrolled in the program listed on their **Offer**; and
 - c. Has no outstanding fees owing; and
 - d. Meets the conditions of their Student Visa.
 - e. GPA of 4.0 or above
6. A Scholarship year is based on consecutive teaching periods of six Terms or three Sessions.
7. Payments will be applied per unit to the maximum scholarship amount for that scholarship year.
8. \$5000 maximum fee reduction for your first scholarship year.
9. For continuing scholarship year/s the value is merit based and calculated on the previous scholarships year's course GPA (across your 8 units* completed):
 - Course GPA 4.0 to 5.4 - \$5000
 - Course GPA 5.5 to 7.0 - \$8000
10. The scholarship will lapse if the **Offer** has passed the lapse date.
11. The scholarship will lapse if the student named on the **Offer** cancels their enrolment at Southern Cross University.
12. The scholarship is not redeemable in cash and subject to the the student complying with all terms and conditions and will be credited, in instalments, to the student's fees each Scholarship year.
13. The scholarship may be withdrawn with 10 days written notice. Tenure checks will be completed after grades are published for each enrolled Teaching Period and the Scholarship may be breached or terminated should the recipient breach any of these conditions.
14. There is a limited number of scholarships available.
