

Employment Model Outcomes for People with Intellectual Disability

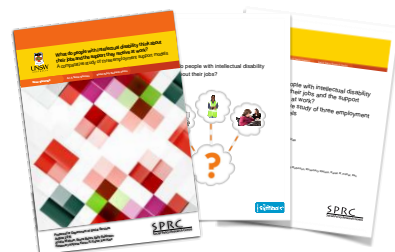
This research was commissioned by the Department of Social Services to examine the experiences people with intellectual disability have with different employment models.

Data was collected from 51 people with intellectual disability working in open employment, Australian Disability Enterprises (ADEs) and social enterprises. The reports highlight their experiences of choosing, finding, maintaining and changing employment, their likes and dislikes about their jobs and outcomes they achieve from working.
